Juice bars are the new coffee bars, as more and more people seek out superfresh fruit and vegetable drinks. Here, America's best new juice joints, F&W's favorite home juicers and a lesson on building layers of flavor like a pro.

CREATIVE JUICES



A Clockwork Orange

To eke out the most liquid, Brandi Kowalski of The Butcher's Daughter in NYC presses the smallest ingredients first (by volume), then works her way up to the largest.

In an electric juicer, juice one 2-inch piece fresh ginger (about 1 ounce), 1 small golden beet (about 4 ounces), 5 medium carrots (about 12 ounces) and ½ medium cantaloupe (about 1 pound) that's been seeded and peeled. Sprinkle the juice very lightly with cayenne pepper and serve right away.

Cilantro-Celery Juice Punch

This bright green blend from Amanda Chantal Bacon of L.A.'s Moon Juice gets its zippy, herby taste from an entire bunch of cilantro.

In an electric juicer, juice one 1-inch piece fresh ginger (about ½ ounce), 1 large bunch cilantro (about 4 ounces), 1 halved and cored Granny Smith apple (about 8 ounces) and 8 celery ribs (about 12 ounces). Stir in 2 teaspoons fresh lemon juice and serve right away.





The new juice-bar mantra: "cold-pressing." Instead of using spinning blades to extract juice, which generate heat and destroy enzymes, cold-press machines rely on slow hydraulic pressure. Here, new spots to sample cold-pressed juice near you.
